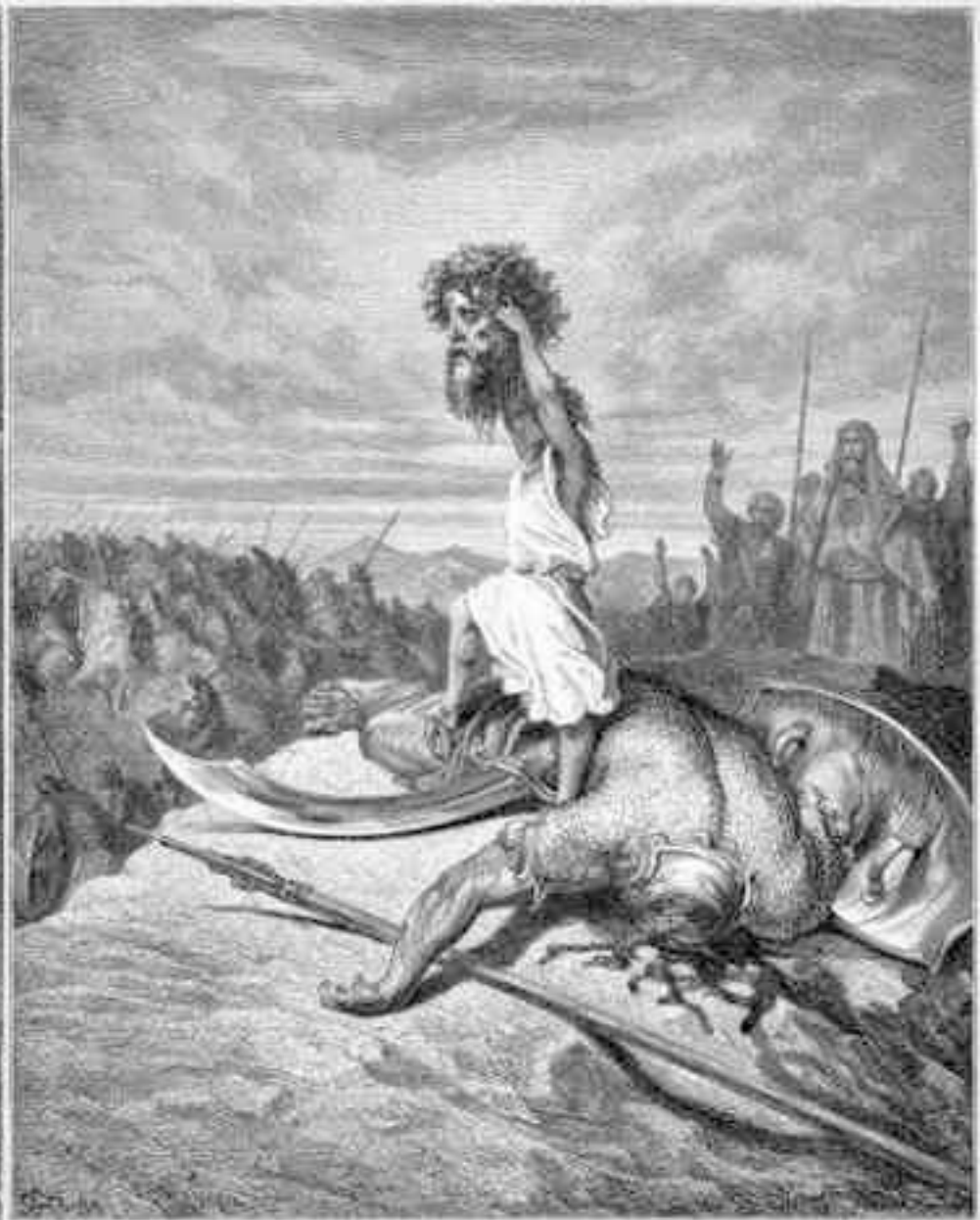

**DAVID AND GOLIATH**

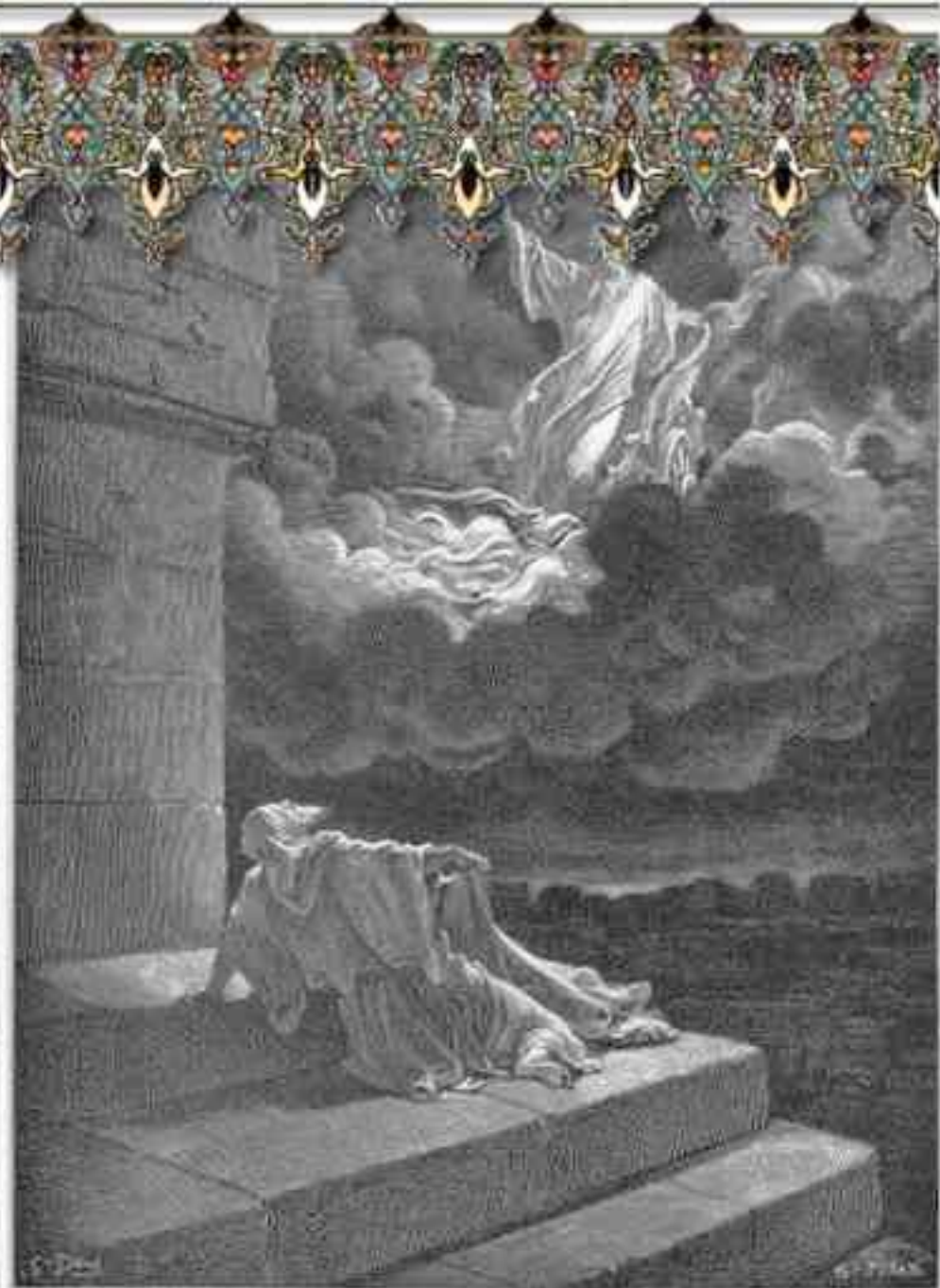
And David put his hand to his hip, and took thence a stone, and slung it, and smote

**ELIJAH DESTROYS THE MESSENGERS OF AHAZIAH BY FIRE**

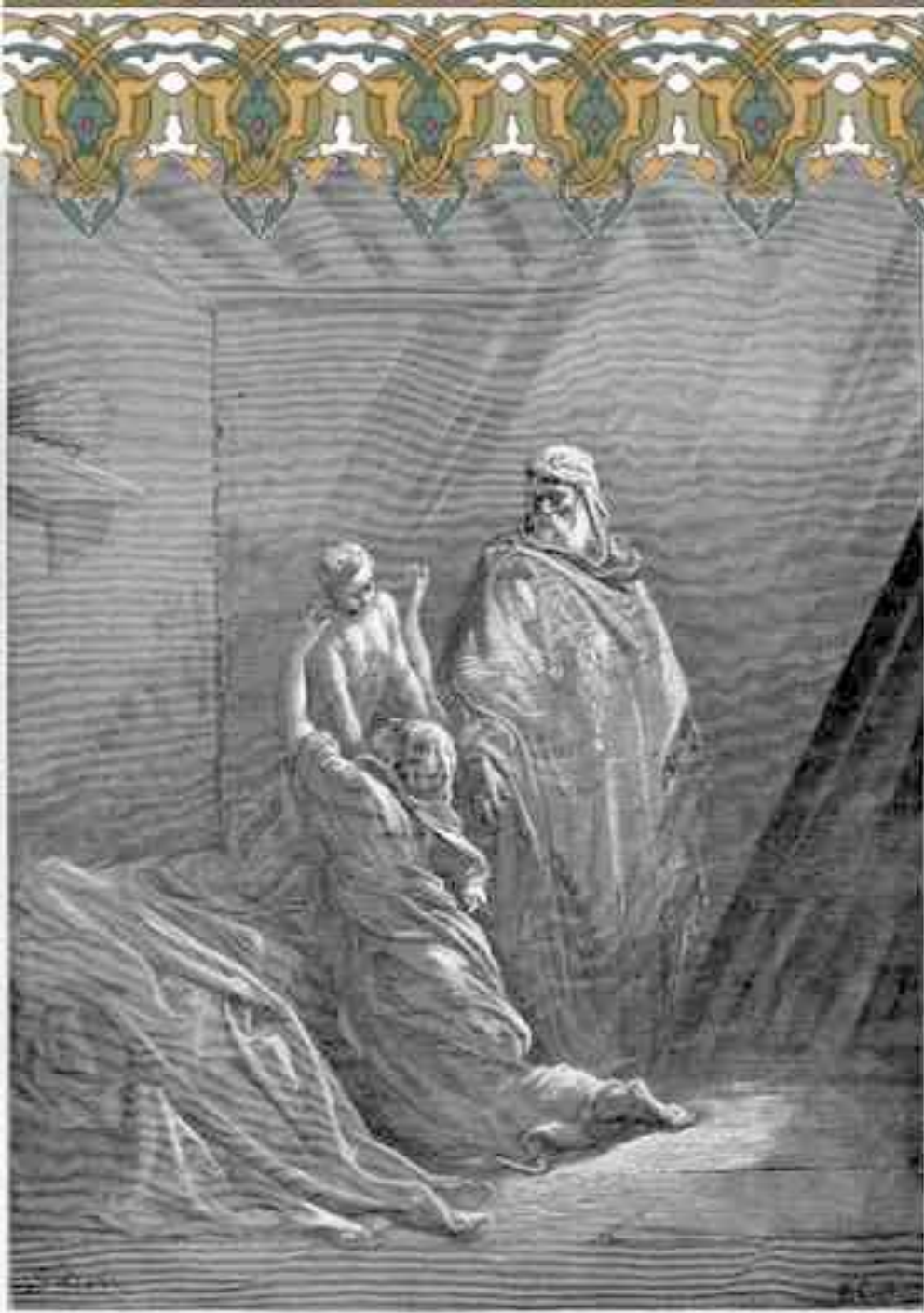
And Elijah answered and said to the captains of Hely: 'It is he a man of God, then let

(Judges 7: 3, 7) (715)





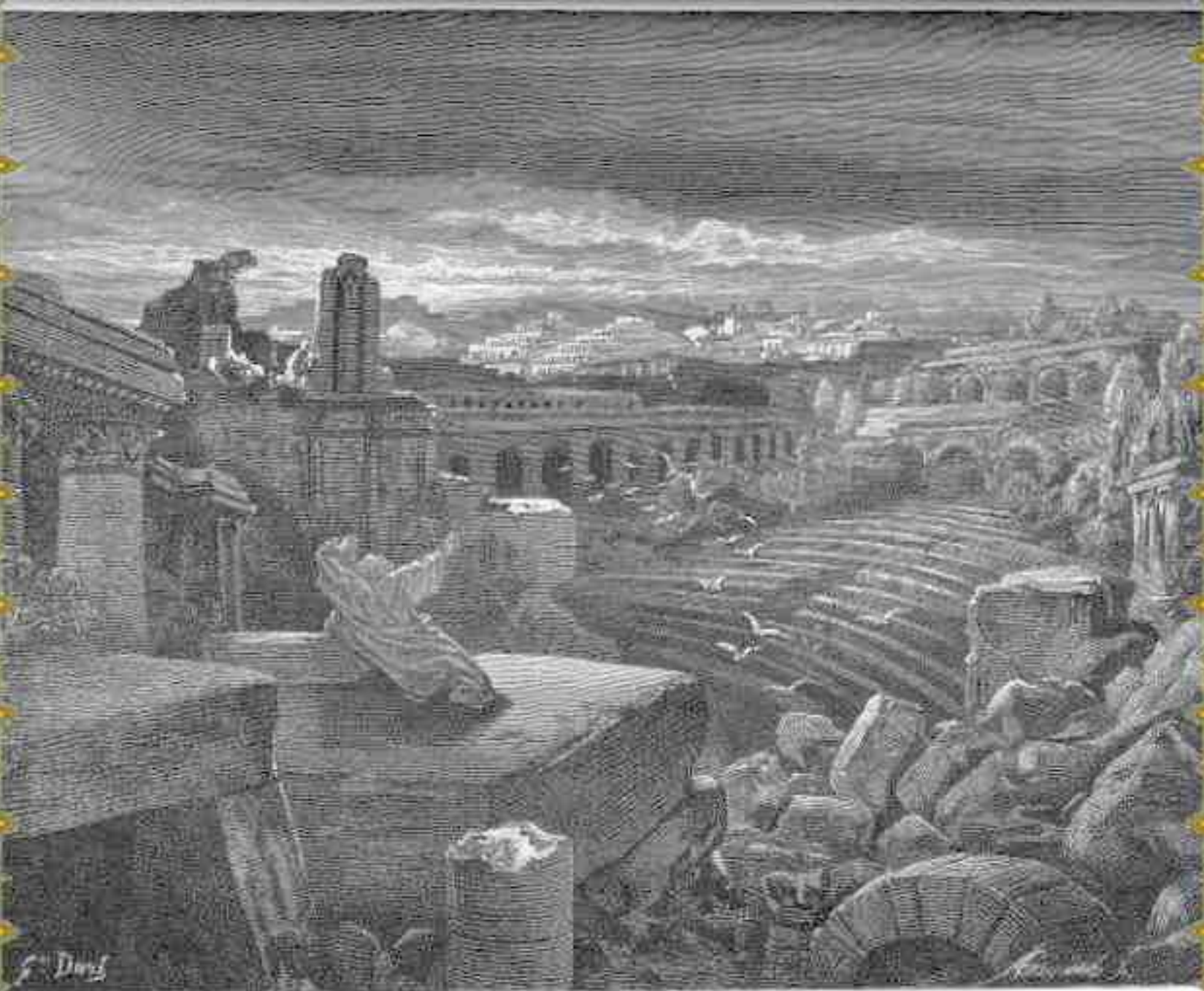
THE STRANGE NATIONS SLAIN BY THE LIONS OF SAMARIA
